The committee in agreement with the Czech and Slovak Table Tennis Associations is organising the eighteen year of the Youth Table Tennis Satellite Tournament.

The entire term of the tournament is from 13th August to 20th August 2009.

as well as some clubs of the organising states Czech, Slovak and Hungary.

The main intention of the satellite tournament is to promote development of youth table tennis in Europe and to find out top-class players in individual categories of younger and older cadets and juniors.

TECHNICAL CONDITIONS

TEAMS

Girls team /younger cadet, older cadet, junior/
Boys team /younger cadet, older cadet, junior/

PLAYERS

1 younger cadet boy / born on **1 st January** 1997 and younger /
1 younger cadet girl / born on **1 st January** 1997 and younger /
1 older cadet boy / born on **1 st January** 1995 and younger /
1 older cadet girl / born on **1 st January** 1995 and younger /
1 junior boy / born on **1 st January** 1992 and younger /
1 junior girl / born on **1 st January** 1992 and younger /

Regarding these conditions a team is formed by 1 younger cadet boy, 1 older cadet boy and 1 junior. Each of them will play one match, so the result could be 3:0 or 2:1. Concerning girls the system is identical.

SINGLES

1. younger cadet boy 3. older cadet boy 5. junior boy
2. younger cadet girl 4. older cadet girl 6. junior girl

THE SYSTEM OF THE COMPETITION

Teams and individuals will play in groups (3-5 participants) in the first round. In the second round 16 best teams or players will play k.o. The players of younger age categories can take part in the older age category in team and in single events, but always only in one age category.

APPLICATIONS AND PAYMENT

The national associations and table tennis clubs can apply for participation in the satellite tournaments. But club participation is selective. Organisers according to their sports and technical conditions and accommodation facilities will make a selection procedure. An application for one event of the three ones in the satellite tournament is also possible.

Expenses have to pay to organisers of individual tournament.

The cost is 25 EUR per day and person /accommodation and meals/, which means 75 EUR per person and one tournament.

One player will pay 10 EUR for his individual participation; it is 5 Euro for team and 5 Euro for single events.

The transport between towns Topolčany - Hluk – Havířov can be provided. Booking in advance is necessary. The participants will pay the cost of transportation extra.
